CoolCrafting Love Birds You will need 2 contrasting colours of felt, 2 colours of thread, 4 cut felt flower shapes, or buttons, 4 pom pom flowers or similar, 2 pieces of ribbon, 4 doll buttons, You will also need scissors and a pencil, needle, 6 pins, stuffing You have enough felt to make two birds. First read through this little book of instructions – ask an adult to help if you are unsure.	Cutting Out You may need to press your instructions, pattern and felt with a warm iron to flatten out the creases. Cut out your paper pattern pieces carefully using scissors. You can choose the colours but we made one bird with an upper body and wings in colour A and the lower body in colour B. And then another bird with an upper body and wings in colour B and the lower body in colour A. Pin your pattern pieces onto the felt and cut carefully around the shapes. You will need one upper body, one lower body and two wings for each bird. Mark the notches with a pencil onto the fabric. 2
Making Up Fold the upper body in half and pin the head and beak together, matching the edges together. Now using an over stitch (about ¼ cm deep) start at the top of the head and stitch around the head, beak and stop at the first mark you made.	Take the pins out and open up the upper body and pin the lower body to it around the curves up to the next mark you have – see the picture. Now sew around one side. Image: Comparison of the image of the picture
Sew the other side the same way. Remove the pins and now match up the tail edge as the picture. Pin and then sew along the long tail edge.	Flatten the tail out, pin and then sew the tail end. All of the outside of the bird is now sewn and you have a V opening to insert the stuffing in. Use a pencil to push small bits of stuffing through the opening into the body and tail.

Over sew the V opening once you are happy that your love bird is the right shape. Now pin both of your wings on, one on each side of the bird. Then overstitch the curve of the wing onto the body of the bird - like in our picture	<text></text>
Finishing Off Join the wing tips with a small stitch. Now fold your ribbon in half and make a soft crease using your fingers. Place the crease in the centre of the back of the bird, as in our picture, and then sew securely in place.
