

Print and Cut Out Patterns: Print the outline image and cut out each rabbit shape .

Trace on Felt: Place each outline on felt fabric folded and trace around it.

Cut Felt Shapes: Carefully cut out the traced shapes on the felt so you have two of each shape.


Sew Together: Stitch around the edges of each rabbit shape using a blanket stitch or an overstitch. leaving a small gap for stuffing. Add in a ribbon or string so you can hang it from your tree.

Stuff with Toy Stuffing and stitch up the gap

Folk Art Embroidery (optional): Add simple folk-style embroidery to embellish the shapes, such as flowers, swirls, or dots.

You may choose to use a button for an eye, or even add beads or sequins.
