



# FOLK RABBITS

**Print and Cut Out Patterns:** Print the outline image and cut out each rabbit shape .

**Trace on Felt:** Place each outline on felt fabric folded and trace around it.

**Cut Felt Shapes:** Carefully cut out the traced shapes on the felt so you have two of each shape.

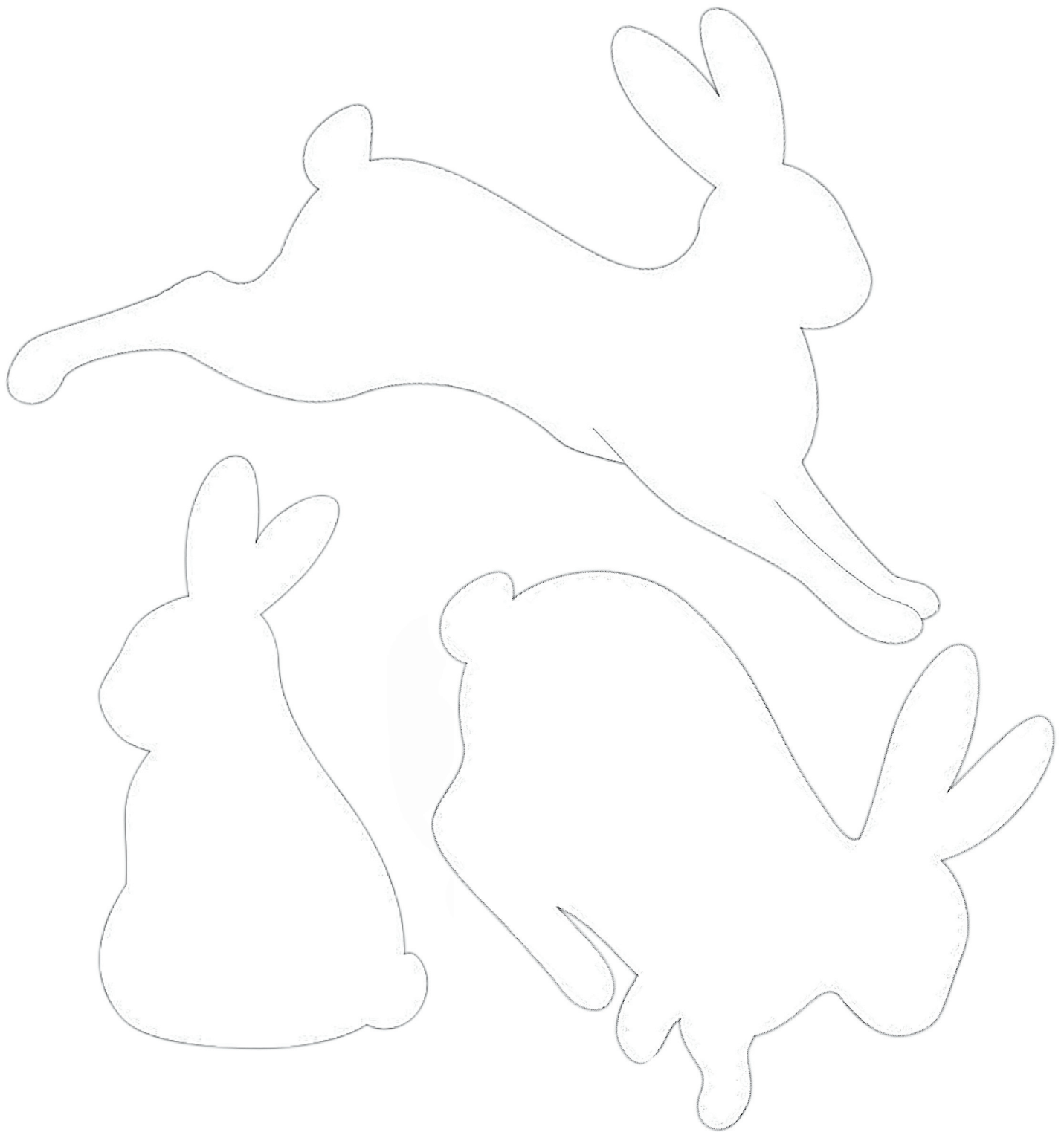
**Sew Together:** Stitch around the edges of each rabbit shape using a blanket stitch or an over stitch. leaving a small gap for stuffing. Add in a ribbon or string so you can hang it from your tree.

**Stuff with Toy Stuffing** and stitch up the gap

**Folk Art Embroidery** (optional): Add simple folk-style embroidery to embellish the shapes, such as flowers, swirls, or dots.

You may choose to use a button for an eye, or even add beads or sequins.
