Jólabókaflóð

Christmas Eve is full of magic — a hush before the day itself, when the house is lit with twinkling lights and the world outside is dark and expectant. It is in this quiet that one of the loveliest traditions takes place: the gifting of a book.

In Iceland, this custom is called Jólabókaflóð — the “Christmas Book Flood.” Families exchange books on the 24th, then curl up with hot chocolate to read late into the night. The tradition began during the 1940s, when wartime shortages made books one of the few gifts widely available. Today it is woven deep into Icelandic Christmas, a celebration of words, imagination, and time spent together.

It’s easy to see why the idea has travelled. Here in Britain, too, December is steeped in stories: Dickens’s ghosts rattling chains in *A Christmas Carol*, Susan Cooper’s *The Dark is Rising* alive with frost and folklore, or the snowy enchantment of *Fifty Words For Snow* by Nancy Campbell.

The beauty of this tradition is in its simplicity. A book can be as small as a picture book for little ones or as grand as a craft book promising projects for the new year. Whatever the choice, the message is the same: here is a story to keep you company through the turning of the year.

Why not try it yourself this Christmas Eve? Wrap a book, brew something warm, and take a quiet hour to read.



Stitching Whimsy into Winter: New Traditions for a Magical Season

Christmas has always been about more than gifts beneath the tree – it is a season of stories, rituals, and small moments of wonder. Beyond the tree and the tinsel lies something older: winter as a time for gathering, imagining, and making magic out of the dark. Here are a handful of ways to weave a little more whimsy into your own season, drawing on folklore, craft, and the quiet creativity that thrives in wintertime.

A Lantern Walk at Dusk

In many folk traditions, light is carried through the dark days as a sign of hope and community. Why not create your own lanterns from jars covered with paper or fabric scraps, and take them out into the garden or street for a Christmas Eve walk or on the year's longest night?

A Winter Tree for the Birds

In Scandinavia, it is customary to hang sheaves of grain or strings of apples outdoors for the birds on Christmas morning. Decorating a tree in the garden with seeds, suet balls, or cranberries not only feeds your feathered neighbours, but turns the outdoors into part of your celebration – a reminder that we share this season with the wild world

Folklore on the Hearth

While the story of Jesus's birth is the obvious choice, every December is rich with old tales: the Snow Queen, the Mari Lwyd, the Green Man peeping out of holly leaves. Choose one and make it your own tradition. You might tell the story by the fire on Christmas Eve, or stitch a character into fabric – a reindeer embroidered on a stocking, or a mythical creature sewn into a child's toy. These threads keep old stories alive.



Our Advent Pick! Merry and Bright Village Advent Calendar DIY Craft Kit by Two for Joy Illustration

While we haven't quite managed to create a Luna-specific Advent calendar this year, we are bringing you the next best thing — a delightful pop-together Advent village!

This **Merry and Bright Advent Craft Kit (£35)** includes 25 beautifully illustrated buildings, plus paper trees and even a frozen lake to set the scene. Each house has its own numbered door, ready to be opened throughout December. The village is filled with festive whimsy — from a Rainbow Bakery and Candy Cane Factory to a Gingerbread Man Adoption Centre and an ice skate hire shop (to go with the lake!).

Inside the box, you'll find everything you need: card pieces, a ruler for scoring, a wooden scorer (perfect for little helpers), and a Pritt Stick. Just add scissors and your crafty enthusiasm!

Once cut, folded, and glued, the little houses can be filled with buttons or ribbons and arranged across a mantelpiece or shelf, creating a joyful, festive scene that grows each day of Advent. A project that's as fun to make as it is to open.

Realistic Felting Kits



There is something magical about shaping soft, unspun wool into a creature that looks as though it might hop, scurry, or fly straight from your hands. Needle felting has become one of our favourite crafts — a rhythmic process that transforms a handful of fibres into lifelike little animals, each with its own charm and character.

We especially love the Chicktin Creations Needle Felting Kits. Each kit comes in a tube and includes everything you need: high-quality wool, sturdy felting needles, and brilliant step-by-step instructions. With Chicktin's expert guidance, the wool seems to spring into shape beneath your fingertips, capturing the delicate realism of fur, ears, wings, and tails.

There are many native woodland friends to choose from — from a bounding rabbit (naturally, Luna Lapin would approve!) to a graceful deer or a cheeky little red squirrel. Each a celebration of the wild world we share.

What is Needle Felting?

Needle felting is the art of using a barbed needle to sculpt wool fibres into firm, solid shapes. Each time the needle pierces the wool, the fibres tangle and compress, gradually forming the curves of a body, the point of a nose, or the flick of a tail. It is a craft that's wonderfully easy to begin — just a little wool, a needle, and time — but one that rewards practice, as each piece becomes more detailed, more true to life.



THE STEGOSAURUS'S BODY, NECK AND HEAD ARE CROCHETED IN ONE PIECE FROM THE TAIL UP. DECORATIVE DETAILS INCLUDE SIMPLE EMBROIDERY, BOBBLES AND PUFF STITCHES.

MATERIALS

- Scheepers 50mcps66, 25% extra fine merino wool, 20% nylon (210m/200m per 50g ball)
- 1 x 50g ball in 002 Midway (A)
- 1 x 50g ball in 003 Sunset (B)
- 1 x 50g ball in 004 Skypark (C)
- 80cm (32in) length of 4ply yarn in pink, such as Scheepers Monopole 452 Bengalen, for the mouth and tongue (D)
- 1 pair of 1/2" (1.25cm) sized beadless glass safety bead eyes or safety eyes
- Clear invisible or strong thread to attach the beaded glass eyes
- Bounded embroidery thread in black, such as Anchor Strand'd Cotton, shade 0005, for the nostrils

- 2.0mm (US2/E) crochet hook
- Stitch markers
- Blunt-ended yarn needle
- Toy stuffing

SIZE

Approximately 141cm (55in) long

TENSION

22 sts and 27 rows to an 10cm (4in) over double crochet using 2.0mm hook and yarn A. Use larger or smaller hook if necessary to obtain correct tension.



Further New Traditions for a Magical Season

Winter Altars

Gather pinecones, sprigs of holly, a feather or stone from a winter walk, and arrange them on a shelf or mantelpiece. Such altars to the season - small collections of natural treasures - connect you to the turning year. Add a handmade candle and light it as twilight falls, letting the flame stand as a marker of time and gratitude.

A Twelve Nights Journal

Old English tradition marked the twelve nights between Christmas and Epiphany as liminal, magical days when the ordinary world left space. Start a simple journal on Christmas night, noting each evening a word, a drawing, or a memory. By Twelfth Night, you will have captured a constellation of your holiday season.

Craft Yourself a Spell

Perhaps the most whimsical act of all is to make something by hand. Sew a star, carve a stamp, knit a scarf - whatever calls to you. In folklore, handmade objects often carried a blessing stitched into them, as though care and intention wove their own quiet enchantment. Each handmade gift you give is part of that lineage: a spell of love tangible.





Let's start with a little festive cheer: **Sarah Hearts** sew-in labels, the perfect way to add a secret smile to your handmade makes.


The CoolCrafting Christmas Surprise
